SECTION 5: RDA FREESTYLE DRESSAGE AND MUSICAL DRESSAGE CREATIONS. This class is open to RDA riders, Volunteers and Coaches. Competitors may either compete individually following one of the EA Freestyle tests (time allowed 4 - 4.30mins) or they may ride a Pas de Deux or Quadrille with a combination of competitors including coaches, volunteers RDA riders. Have fun

(Maximum time allowed for the pas de deux and quadrille is 8mins) There are no compulsory movements for the pas de deux or Quadrille but a balanced test of equal movements on both reins is recommended.

Equitation jumping is the physical application of correct riding techniques while jumping a simple course of fences. It is judged over one round and no time is involved. Rider is judged on their correct approach to the fence and position over the fence.

Video Guidance

Please take the time to read these instructions carefully as videos not meeting the directive will be eliminated.

- Videos must be taken from a device mounted on a tripod.
- The video should start just before the rider enters at A, (it should not showmore than 5 seconds of recording before entry.)
- The video should end as the rider circles away after their halt, to leave thearena at A.
- No editing of the recording will be allowed under penalty of elimination.
- If using a USB the device should not contain any other recordings.
- The camera operator must be positioned outside of the arena 5mtrs behindC, clearly showing the letters. Make sure that all of the arena edges are visible.
- The camera operator must ensure that <u>ALL</u> of the horse, rider and arenamarkers on the side where the horse is, are always visible.
- The centre line must be visible at all times.
- The Video must include a sound recording. (This is to detect coaching during a test, **but** tests may be called)Coach must stand outside the arenaat E or B.
- Poor quality videos may not be judged at the discretion of the judges. Thisrefers to lack of suitable light, insufficient contrast between subject and background, lack of focus or excessive movement by the operator. (It is recommended the camera is placed on a stand)
- Tests must be ridden and filmed in a 40m x 20m arena unless otherwise specified in test. Riders must be in neat riding attire e.g. Shirt & tie, V neck jumper with Shirt & tie, riding coat etc. Horses should be presented clean butplaiting is not required.

Riders/ Volunteers/ Coaches will all be covered as per normal, as this is an RDA activity. Normal rules must be followed RDA riders/ Volunteers who are entering on RDA horses need to be supervised by an RDA coach on horses suitable to their riding abilities.
