

CHILD SAFE STANDARD 2: A child safe policy or statement of commitment to child safety.

Standard 2: RDA Centres can create a child safe environment by:

- Promoting and displaying the RDA Victoria Child Safe Policy and Commitment to Child Safety, making it clear to children, their families, your volunteers, contractors and community that your Centre is committed to the protection of children.
- Affirm commitment to child safety and the best interests of children in communications.

Practical things Centres can do:

- Include child safety information in volunteer and client welcome packs and induction.
- Communicate the statement and policy by display on noticeboard, on web sites, in social media and newsletters.
- Include it in regular update training for volunteers and coaches.
